One 14KT yellow gold lady's ring with a bright polish finish. Condition is very good. The center stone is channel set with 2 diamonds set in white gold bezels on both sides. The ring measures 12.85mm wide and is fitted with a 8mm Superfit hinged shank. Previous appraisal states "Phillip Original Jewelry Designs" Containing:

One round brilliant cut diamond, measuring 9.91 - 9.87 x 6.20mm (depth est.), 7.00% GTCF approximate weight of 4.00ct with a medium blue fluorescence. Low SI-2 clarity..
